- An item submitted will be published for no more than two consecutive months. (One month, unless otherwise requested.)

- After that, it will be withdrawn.

- It will be published again for no more than two consecutive months only if the member resubmits the item by contacting their fieldman or by writing or calling the Novi office.

- Reference to a name of a firm or other commercial enterprise with which a member is involved will be deleted, with permission of the member.

- If the member does not wish such deletion, he may choose to have the item published as a Classified Ad at the regular per-line Classified Ad rate.

- Freeliners must be received by the 10th of the month preceding the desired month of publication.

Example – to be included in the January issue, the freeliner must be at the MMPA office by December 10th.
